V. Department of Administration

The Department of Administration handles planning and external affairs, general affairs, accounting, research supports, and facility management work.

The major operations of the Department of Administration are to support the promotion of the institute's regular research and the development of the collaborative research. These operations are expected to become more complicated in the future.

In order to work with appropriate stronger judgment and to provide broader convenience to collaborative researchers, the Department of Administration was reorganized in October, 2006.

The new Department consists of the following four divisions, namely, Planning and External Affairs Division, General Affairs Division, Research Promotion Division, and Facilities and Safety Management Division. Details of these Divisions are described in the following.

Planning and External Affairs Division

Planning and External Affairs Division aims at handling the activities as the Institute and accepting visitors who are interested in. Planning Office consists of two sections: Financial Planning and Budget Section is in charge of making plan about income, expense and budget. Objective Planning and Evaluation Section is in charge of works to make mid-term goals, mid-term plan, annual plan, performance report and peer review. External Affairs Office consists of three sections: Secretary Section is in charge of secretarial works for the Director-General and the Deputy Director-General. Press and Community Relation Section is in charge of cooperation with community, public activities, Information Disclosure. International Affairs Section is in charge of works for international academic scientific agreements and international cooperative projects.

General Affairs Division

General Affairs Division consists of eight Sections: General Affairs Section, Documents and Legal Affairs Section, Personnel Section, Salaries and Welfare Section, Financial Affairs Section, Cashier Section, Accounts Section and Contracts Section.

Major responsibilities of the division are: to provide administrative as well as financial supports for the Administrative Council for Research and Management and the CEO meetings; to prepare for various ceremonies and events; to offer documents services; to enact rules and regulations; to work for general personnel affairs, salary, and public welfare; to execute budget; to manage corporate property, revenue/expenditure, and traveling expenses of staffs; and to purchase supply of articles.
