V. Department of Administration

The Department of Administration handles planning and external affairs, general affairs, accounting, research supports, and facility management work.

The major operations of this department are to support the promotion of the institute's regular research and the development of the collaborative research.

It consists of the following four divisions, namely, General Affairs Division, Financial Affairs Division, Research Support Division, and Facilities and Safety Management Division. Details of these Divisions are described in the following.

General Affairs Division

General Affairs Division handles administrative work and serves as contact point with the outside. This Division consists of four sections: General Affairs Section is in charge of secretarial work for the Director-General and the Deputy Director-General, supports for the Administrative Council meetings, enacting rules and regulations; Planning and Evaluation Section is in support for assessment of the Institution's performance including scientific achievement and management efficiency; Personnel and Payroll Section is in charge of general personnel affairs, salary, and public welfare; Communications and Public Affairs Section is for outreach and publicity activities.
