Announcement of Open Recruitment

The National Institute for Fusion Science (NIFS) seeks young researchers with advanced research ability for promoting fusion science by engaging them in research for a fixed period of employment. Guidelines follow below.

1. Title and Number of positions to be filled

Title: Center of Excellence Researcher (a post-doctoral fixed-term researcher)

Number: Several

2. Purpose of NIFS

To promote fusion science and its application

3. Requirements for applicants

Applicants should meet either of the following qualifications:

- (1) Holding the Ph.D. degree and be within eight years since receiving that degree
- (2) To receive the Ph.D. degree before the start of employment on October 1, 2024

4. Research fields

(Immediately after hiring) Fusion science and related research.

(Scope of change) No change.

5. Term of appointment

From October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2026. (Contract renewal: No renewal) If the applicant has been employed at NIFS as a Center of Excellence Researcher before September 30, 2024, the period of employment will be two years maximum, including that period. When the start of the employment is delayed from October 1, 2024 due to conditions for which the applicant is not responsible, the period of employment will be two years from the start of the employment.

6. Salary

Approximately 4,000,000 Japanese yen a year including taxes.

(Approximately 340,000 Japanese yen each month including taxes.)

7. Application deadline

Friday, July 19, 2024, by 17:00 (5:00 p.m.), Japan time

8. Selection system

Selection will be made by the Administrative Council of NIFS. The decision will be based upon the examination of documents. However, if necessary, an interview may be conducted. In the event that appropriate candidates cannot be found, all posts may not be filled.

9. Documents to be submitted

The following documents (1) - (5) must be submitted via e-mail (see Section 10. for e-mail address). For the letter of recommendation (6), please follow the instructions in Section 10.

(1) Resume: use the designated form of NIFS.

(<https://www.nifs.ac.jp/en/about/recruit/index.html>) The date of birth and possible starting date should be written. One color photograph should be affixed. If the applicant has received a Ph.D. degree, please state the name of the degree and the date received. Contact information should include an e-mail address.

(2) Research history: any format with a title which is your research project is acceptable, however, this text should not exceed three pages single-spaced. Please describe the research conducted as a Ph.D. student and as an M.S. student.

(3) Research topic upon employment: any format is acceptable, however, this text should not exceed two pages single-spaced. Potential candidates should design a research plan together with the desired supervisor at NIFS for approval before applying. The name of that individual should be included in this text.

(4) List of publications: any format is acceptable. All co-authors should be included. The papers should be noted as “refereed” or “not refereed.” On a separate page(s), the candidate will write a brief summary of each publication and describe her/his contributions. In compiling the publication list, “Guidelines for compiling the list of publications”

(<https://www.nifs.ac.jp/en/about/recruit/index.html>) should be consulted.

(5) Offprints: offprints of three major publications should be included. Should the candidate not yet have publications, a dissertation, papers under review for possible publication, or papers in preparation may be included. Photocopies are acceptable. Also, as stated in (4), all Applicants should write a brief summary of each publication and describe her/his contributions. (any format)

(6) Letters of recommendation: any format is acceptable.

All of the above documents should be A4 size and should convert to each separate PDF file.

The applicant’s name should be typed in the upper right corner of all pages of the submitted documents.
