

※Requirements on the use of power-assisted bicycles※

1 . Please obey the traffic rules and ride the power-assisted bicycle (herein after referred to as “the bicycle”) safely.

2 . Please have charge of the bicycle by the user him/herself.

3 . The user should bear all compensation liability for damages caused by a bicycle accident.

When you have an accident, please call police (Tajimi Police Station) and Visitor Center.

Please buy bicycle insurance by yourself.

4 . The user should bear compensation liability for stolen, damaged, etc. of the bicycle except for minor damages. However, the user does not take a responsible for changing consumable supplies such as batteries.

If there is something wrong with the bicycle, please report to Visitor Center.

※The user should take a responsible for losing the key.

5 . Please return the key to Visitor Center after use.

If you return the key after 5p.m. weekday, please return the key by 10a.m. the next day. If the next day is holiday or weekend, please return the key by 10a.m. the next business day.

※Please park the bicycle in the prescribed position.

6 . Please abide this requirements, otherwise you cannot rent the bicycle.

※Visitor Center Business Hour 9:00 – 17:00 Weekday

※If you use the bicycle after return date without permission, Visitor Center cannot lend you the bicycle from the next time.

※Please surely put the light on in the night and in a dense fog.

※Please ride on the left side of the road.

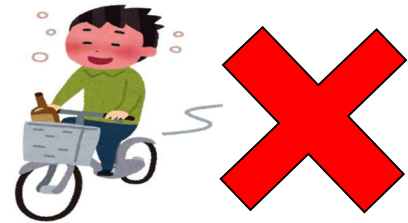

Please observe the bicycle safety rules

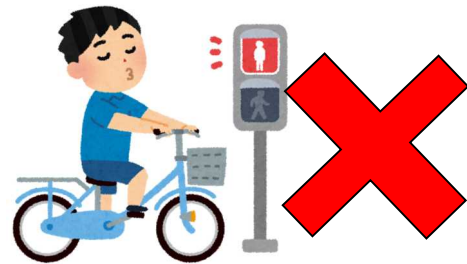
Prohibition on drink-drive (a maximum of 5 years imprisonment or a fine of up to 1,000,000 yen)



Put the light on in the night (a fine of up to 50,000 yen)



Observe traffic signals, stop and confirm the safety (a maximum of 3 months imprisonment or a fine of up to 50,000 yen)



Ride on the left side (a maximum of 3 months imprisonment or a fine of up to 50,000 yen)
